Graduated from the Conservatorio Superior de Música of Salamanca where he was the principal oboe of the college symphony orchestra, working with the conductors Lutz Köhler and Pablo González as well as being a member of the conservatory wind quintet.

Awarded with the scholarships "Jovenes en concierto" 2005, and Erasmus 2007, which allowed him to continue his studies at the Haute école de musique de Genève where he obtained his master's degree in oboe, specialized in Pedagogie.

He has played with different orchestras in Switzerland, the Orchestra de chambre de Genève, Emsemble Contrechamps, Orchestra de Lancy-Genève, Orchestra de chambre de Meyrin, Sinfonietta de Genève, Puplinge Classique orchestra festival, among others.

He has worked with conductors like Wolfgang Lischke, François Xavier Roth, Gérard Caussé, Chosei Komatsu, David Greilsammer and recorded for Radio Televisión Española and Radio Télévision Suisse.

He has also performed with artists such as Sonya Yoncheva, Pierre Amoyal, Didier Lockwood.

An active chamber musician, he has been a member of the Avensemble since 2014. He has recognized experience in teaching, his students having always obtained high results during the course of their studies. His main goal has always been to transmit the enjoyment that music provides through the study of the oboe.
